AMIA SYMPOSIUM IN ATLANTA, GA



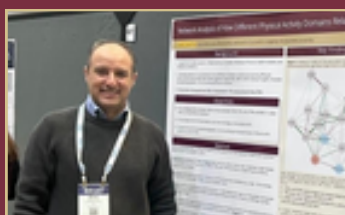

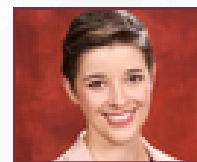
Daniel presented two abstracts on direct effect of physical activity on mild cognitive impairment, and indirect effect considering psychosocial variables.
